

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL  
CITY OF PORT ALLEN, LOUISIANA  
MONDAY, JUNE 27, 2016**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Port Allen, Louisiana, met in Special Session at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 27, 2016, in the Council Chambers at Port Allen City Hall.

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and asked Terry Jones to lead the pledge of allegiance. Roll was called, resulting as follows:

Mayor Lee asked the City Council members to consider a formal resolution to authorize the mayor to submit an application for a federal grant to assist the city with plans to design a walking trail to connect the levee by the current Municipal Complex and park area with Whitehead Boulevard to Rivault Park.
