

**SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL  
CITY OF PORT ALLEN, LOUISIANA  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 27, 2018**

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Port Allen, Louisiana, met in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, June 27, 2018, in the Council Chambers at Port Allen City Hall.

Mayor Lee called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Roll was called, resulting as follows:

Mayor Lee asked Lance Guidry to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Hugh Riviere moved to go into Executive Session to discuss the status and strategy in the matter entitled "City of Port Allen versus Energy Services South, LLC, et al," Number 44405 on the docket of the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court. Mr. Brandon Brown seconded the motion. Mayor Lee asked if there was any objection. There was none. A roll call vote resulted as follows: YEAS: Brown, Hubble, Lawrence, Riviere, Williams. NAYS: None. ABSENT: None. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

When the members of the City Council returned to the Council Chambers, Mr. Garry Hubble moved to return to the Regular Agenda. Mr. Brandon Brown seconded the motion. Mr. Carey Williams moved to approve the recommendation of the City Attorney to settle the lawsuit mentioned above and authorize Mayor Lee to sign all documents associated with the implementation of this settlement agreement. Mrs. Ray Helen Lawrence seconded the motion. Mayor Lee asked if there was any objection. There was none. A roll call vote resulted as follows: YEAS: Brown, Hubble, Lawrence, Riviere, Williams. NAYS: None. ABSENT: None. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mr. Brandon Brown moved to go into Executive Session to discuss the status and strategy in the matter entitled "Patrick J. Marshall versus Port Allen Police Department, et al," Number 3.18-cv-00649-JWD-EWD on the docket of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana. Mr. Garry Hubble seconded the motion. Mayor Lee asked if there was any objection. There was none. A roll call vote resulted as follows: YEAS: Brown, Hubble, Lawrence, Riviere, Williams. NAYS: None. ABSENT: None. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

When the members of the City Council returned to the Council Chambers, Mr. Brandon Brown moved to return to the Regular Agenda. Mr. Garry Hubble seconded the motion. Mayor Lee announced that the City of Baker would be hosting a Prayer Breakfast on Friday, June 29<sup>th</sup> at Baker City Hall. The Mayor announced that he received a letter from the West Baton Rouge Uniforms for Kids asking for donations and stated that there would be a Retirement Party at City Hall for Johnny Hicks whose last day is June 29<sup>th</sup> after 18 years of service to the City of Port Allen. Mayor Lee stated that he had received several complaints from customers on garbage service and that he and the Chief Administrative Officer had recently met with the management of Republic to discuss these issues.

There being no further business to come before the City Council, Mr. Hugh Riviere moved to adjourn. Mr. Brandon Brown seconded the motion and the motion carried without objection and the meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
